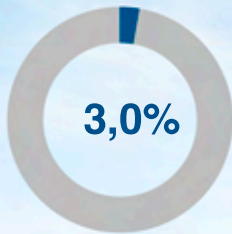
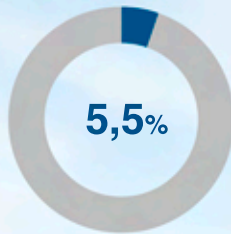

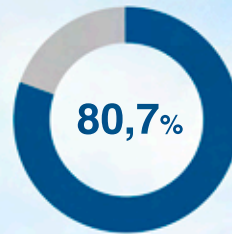
1 Fish purchases by SALICA over the period 01.10.2020-30.09.2021 by type of provider:



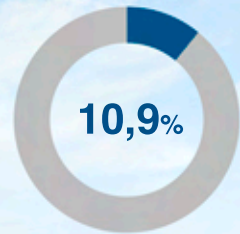

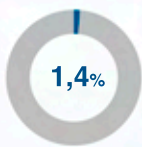

MSC-certified fisheries.



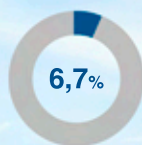
Vessels participating in a Fishery Improvement Project (FIP) rated A, B or C.

In accordance with the provisions of our Responsible Purchasing Policy, we work every day to improve the sustainability of the fishing resource, committing ourselves to reduce the percentages of purchase of fish that do not belong to any of the established categories.

Likewise, and with the aim of improving the stock of Yellowfin in the Indian Ocean, we undertake to limit its purchase as of October 1, 2021, reducing it annually by 11%, taking as a reference value the purchases made in the period 2017-2019.

True to our responsible purchasing policy, 100% of the fish caught by longliners comes from vessels registered in the PVR.
